The first feature race will be a heads up start. The winner of the first race will roll two dice in the winner's circle to determine the inversion of lead lap cars for the starting lineup of the second race. This process will be repeated for the third feature. Should the same driver win the first two races, a third dice will be added to the roll in the winner's circle.

Should a qualified driver start in race one but fail to make the lineup for race two, a 'bubble' car may be invited to fill the field. It is the promoter's option to determine which cars – if any - may be added to the field.

Drivers will earn points for their performance in each race. The total points earned on the day will determine the final paying performance ranking.
